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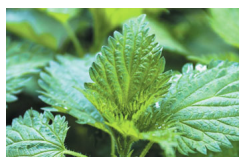

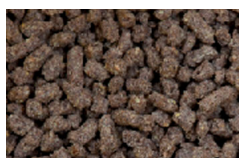

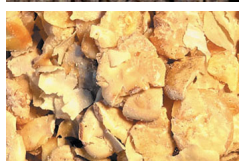
Nettles

Nettle is rich in minerals (calcium, potassium, magnesium, iron, phosphorus) and trace elements and silicon in particular.



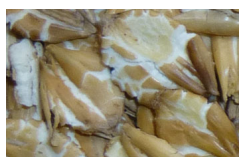
Linamix®

Flaked cereals

Flaked cereals are highly digestible further to their cooking and rolling.



Alfalfa

High-quality fibres containing essential amino acids and calcium.



Cereal corrector
